Criteria for T-Shirt Submissions
Fair Housing Resource Center, Inc. has set the following guidelines for the annual t-shirt design contest. Please review these guidelines with the students to ensure everyone has an opportunity to participate.
☐ Anyone 18 and under is eligible to participate in our T-Shirt Contest.
☐ Designs must incorporate creative and original artwork and ideas. Depictions of cartoons, video games movie/television characters; celebrities; movie themes; designs do not constitute creativity and originality.
☐ Designs must deliver a clear and positive message to promote equality and diversity
☐ Designs must be no larger than standard board size (22" x 28") and no smaller than 8.5" x 11".
□ Please refrain from writing your name or other identifying information on the front of the design. The design entry numbers should not be marked on the front of the design either. Please tape the entry form on the back of the submission.
☐ Individuals may use a variety of art mediums, such as watercolor, pen and ink, crayon, chalk, markers, etc Keep in mind that the winning design will be reproduced or reprinted, so clear artwork and easy-to-read messages are best.
☐ Computer clip art, pictures from magazines and other print media, or any other copyrighted brand or production images will not be accepted.
☐ Individuals may submit multiple entries
□ Individuals may not work in pairs
☐ Failure to comply with the guidelines could result in a disqualification of the T-Shirt entry

Judging

☐ Release forms and Submission forms are required to be signed and submitted with entry to qualify

Designs will be judged on their artistry, creativity, originality, and their ability to communicate a clear and positive message promoting equality and diversity. We ask that all individuals comply with the above rules.
